Brief Summary of Instructional Program _____

Working with families and the community, Lemira Elementary School continues to develop the world-class skills and life and career characteristics of the Profile of the Graduate to develop the whole child as a productive, competent, college and career ready member of society through challenging learning opportunities.

Leadership skills continue to be integrated into the curriculum and are correlated with best practices. Teachers are actively engaged in professional development and have created High Progress Literacy Classrooms as a part of the South Carolina Read to Succeed Endorsement. Professional learning communities relating to Read to Succeed, Technology, STEAM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts and Math), Integration of the Arts, MTSS (Multi-Tiered System of Supports), data and leadership enhanced the professional growth of all teachers.

Students are actively engaged in learning experiences to increase fluency in math. Using a variety of software, manipulatives and other instructional strategies in both the classroom and computer lab proved to assist students in the mastery of math fluency. Classes visit the Reflex Math Lab twice a week to provide opportunities for students to have frequent practice in basic math skills.

Through MTSS, Lemira uses learning supports such as: Classroom Enrichment, Transitions, Community Collaboration, Family Engagement, Crisis Prevention, and Student and Family Interventions to provide opportunities for the school to be proactive in addressing student needs. We have also expanded our college bound and leadership initiatives which supports our theme of Creating College and Career Ready Leaders. All stakeholders promote an atmosphere of leadership and high expectations for life-long learners.
