Brief Description of Instructional Program _____



We demonstrate our vision by preparing all students for a global technological workforce and post-secondary education.

Serving the three high schools in Sumter County, we enjoy a positive relationship with our business and industrial partners while continuing to develop positive relationships with our stakeholders in the community. The principal is actively involved with the Chamber and Rotary and we participate in the district community outreach program of Principal for the Day, in which a key community member experiences a day in the life of a principal. We regularly bring in guest speakers to address our students and share their real world experiences.

The administration and faculty emphasize instructional rigor, and we work diligently with district guidance counselors to ensure that students at the Career Center meet specific prerequisites for enrollment. Our faculty and staff have taken advantage of professional development opportunities with a focus on effective teaching practices, and have formed data teams that make effective instructional decisions based upon the analysis of student data.

Our partnership with Central Carolina Technical College remains strong. Several students from our early childhood class are dually enrolled, and they receive post-secondary credit during the school year. We also have dual enrollment opportunities for our Mechatronics and STEM10 programs. We are excited that more students have passed their entrance test for CCTC and will also enroll this summer and fall.
