### **Faculty Profile**

At Willow Drive Elementary, we are “all in...every child, every day, whatever it takes!” Willow Drive has a staff of 81 and includes a principal, assistant principal, curriculum resource teacher, math interventionist, three reading interventionists, 29 regular classroom teachers, two self-contained ED, two LD resource, one Speech, and one ESOL teacher. We also have a literacy coach, behavior interventionist, part-time district social worker, counselor, part-time district psychologist, art teacher, music teacher, physical education teacher, media specialist, computer/technology teacher assistant, secretary/bookkeeper, attendance clerk, guidance secretary, full-time nurse, 11 paraprofessionals, seven custodians, and eight cafeteria workers. The professional staff at Willow Drive remains fairly consistent with few teachers retiring or transferring each year. Willow Drive has five teachers who are National Board Certified, ten with master’s plus 30 degrees, 18 with master’s degrees, 15 with bachelor’s plus 18, and six with bachelor’s degrees. The majority of the staff has at least ten years teaching experience.

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
